Anti-inflammatory creams for muscles and joints:

Name: (KCBL)

- Ketoprofen 15%
- Cyclobenzaprine 2%
- Baclofen 2%
- Lidocaine 5%

Neuropathic and anti-inflammatory combination creams:

Name: (DBBG)

- Diclofenac 5%
- Baclofen 2%
- Bupivacaine 1%
- Gabapentin 6%

Name: (KBCDG)

- Ketamine 10%
- Bupivacaine 1%
- Cyclobenzaprine 2%
- Diclofenac 5%
- Gabapentin 6%

Miscellaneous

Name: Gout cream

- Diclofenac 5%
- Bupivacaine 1%
- Colchicine 0.05%
- Indomethacin 2%
- Loperamide 1%
- TAC 0.1%
